LOCAL RODEO ENTRY PROCEDURE

- ⊛ All Local Entries need to know when, where and what time to call back to see when they drew up at the Rodeo. Please see your sanction form for dates. You can Post the date, website and telephone number when taking the entries, and make sure they read the poster. If they call the state office it will cost them an extra \$5.00 that is a rule.
- ⊛ Please follow the guidelines below. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to call the State Office, I will be glad to answer any questions. Welcome to the 2018 CPRA Rodeo Season. The CPRA Board of Directors is please to have your Rodeo as a Team Member in conjunction with CPRA. Together we can make great things happen.
We strongly urge you to collect your local entry fees before you email your entries to Central Entry. Your committee is responsible for each entry, and their entry fee. Every entry that is emailed to Central Entry is guaranteed by you.
Lots of local committees are taking entries in person, and cash only. We can advertise anyway you wish.
Your Committee must present the Rodeo Secretary with the total amount of entry fees for your local entries, before the Rodeo starts, and in one lump sum. This may be a Committee check, money order, or cash.
 - 1 **ALL LOCAL ENTRIES** must be emailed to central entry the Friday before the scheduled entry call-in Monday before your rodeo.
 - 2 **Email:** info@midwestrodeoentries.com
 - 3 **Dates:** for local entries are your option, however, they **must close** the Friday before your Monday call-in entry date.
 - 4 **Time and Place:** for local entries are at your discretion.
 - 5 **Entry Fees:** THE MASTER FORM HAS YOUR TOTALS CALCULATED FOR YOU. You will receive one master form with your entry fees and one blank form for copies.
 - 6 You as a committee may add your own office charge. It must be over and above the CPRA charges.
 - 7 **Contestant** must fill out the Local Entry form, and sign a release waiver. (Forms provided to you by the CPRA)
 - 8 **Please let your local entries know they must call back** to find out when they are “up”.
 - 9 **Late Entries:** No late local entries.
 - 10 **Non-Members:** Non-members and any local who did not meet your deadline may enter through Central Entry at the specified date and time. They will be assessed a non-member fee of \$25.00, and must contact the State Office to put a credit card on file (to secure entry) and be assigned a non-member number before entering with central entry. They can pay their fees at the rodeo, but with CASH only.
 - 11 **Call Backs:** All Contestants, including locals, are responsible for making their call back to the Entry Office. Callback dates can be obtained from the state office. **Callbacks can be done online or over the phone.**
 - 12 **Preference:** Locals and non-members will not be given a position preference. Locals are guaranteed at least 10% of each event in the rodeo performance.

We must have Contestants fill out the personal information on their entry form. Be sure you have everything including their Social Security Number, along with their signature. Each contestant can circle the event(s) they wish to enter (incase of phone entries, please fill out the entire form as they enter) check all figures when giving a grand total. Open/Mixed Team Ropers, sometime they want to pay per man, sometimes per team, the form is adaptable to either scenario. Be sure you collect from each team member. **CAUTION:** double check who is Heading and who is Heeling. It makes a big difference when posting results. **Entering with a Preference:** the date or performance the entry wishes to participate in, example, 1st performance or slack. Do not use dates when requesting a preference choice, use performances, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, slack etc. Locals cannot give an “out” as their 2nd preference.

NON-MEMBER RELEASE FORM

CPRA RELEASE WAIVER RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (herein defined and including but not limited to the rodeo arena, competition area, chutes, pens, areas reserved and intended for participants or restricted to the general public, and all walkways, concessions and other areas appurtenant to any area where any activity related to the event shall take place, or being permitted to compete, officiate, observe work for, or for any purpose participate in any way in the event. EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin, acknowledges, agrees, and represents that he has, or will immediately upon entering any of such restricted areas, and will continuously thereafter, inspect such restricted areas and all portions thereof which he enters and with which he comes in contact, and he does further warrant that his entry upon such restricted area or areas and his participation, if any in the event constitutes an acknowledgment that he has inspected such restricted areas and if he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the restricted areas:

1. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the participants, sanctioning organization or any subdivision thereof, rodeo committee, stock contractor, rodeo association, arena operators or owners, officials, any persons in any restricted area, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners, and lessee or premises used to conduct the event and each of them their officers and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "released" from all liability to the undersigned his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise while the undersigned is in or upon the restricted area, and/or competing, officiating in, observing, working for, or for any purpose participating in the event:

2. HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releases and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing, or working for or for any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by the negligence of the releasee otherwise.

3. HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of releasee or otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing, or working for or for any purpose participating in the event.

EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED expressly acknowledges and agrees that the activities of the event are very dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or property damage. EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agree that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive and is permitted by the law of the Province or State in which the event is conducted and that is any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE WAIVER OR LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements, or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.

I HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT. I UNDERSTAND IT IS A RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS. I UNDERSTAND I ASSUME ALL RISK INHERENT IN RODEO. I VOLUNTARILY SIGN MY NAME EVIDENCING MY ACCEPTANCE OF THE ABOVE PROVISIONS.

MINOR'S RELEASE ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

Effective Date: _____

We, the undersigned, hereby request that the below name minor be granted permission (1) one to enter the restricted area, (2) two to participate as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in rodeo events. (3) Three to compete for money, prizes, or reward. (4) Four to be covered by participants' hospitalization insurance, if applicable, as limited by the master policy (all collectively hereinafter called "permissive entry").

In consideration of "permissive entry" to minor into the restricted area, which is the area from which admission to the general public in restricted, which includes, but is not limited to the rodeo arena, competition area, chutes, pens, adjacent walkways, concessions, and other appurtenances, we the undersigned, on behalf of the minor and for ourselves, our personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, spouses and assigns, do hereby:

- 1. RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the rodeo committee, stock contractor, rodeo association, sponsors, arena operators or owners and each of them, their officers, agents and employees (all hereinafter collectively referred to as "releases") from any and all claims and liability arising out of strict liability or ordinary negligence of releases or any other participant which causes the undersigned injury, death, damages or property damage. We, the undersigned, jointly, severally, and in common, covenant to hold releases harmless and to indemnify release from any claim, judgement or expenses (releases may incur arising out of any of the minor's activities or presence in the restricted area).
2. UNDERSTAND the minor's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in rodeo events contains DANGER AND RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH TO MINOR, that conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable, and that there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which we each appreciate and voluntarily choose to do so. Each of the undersigned has observed events of the type that the minor seeks to participate in. We further understand that the arena surface, access ways or lack thereof, lighting or lack thereof, and weather conditions all change and pose a danger to the minor. We further understand that other contestants and participants pose a danger to the minor, but nevertheless, WE EACH VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ACCEPT ALL RISKS connected with the minor's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in any rodeo events.
3. AGREE that this agreement shall apply to any incident, injury, accident or death occurring on the above date and FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR THEREAFTER or until the minor's association membership expires, whichever shall last occur. All subsequent agreements and release documents signed by any of the undersigned shall amplify, but shall in no way limit the provisions of this document. The provisions of this document may be cancelled by any one of the undersigned by delivering to the above rodeo association written cancellation of the agreement which shall be effective 24 hours after the date said cancellation is actually received by the rodeo association.
